



HKI Arb Fellowship Assessment Course from 11th to 13th January 2008 **& Award Writing Examination on 19th January 2008**

The Chinese University School of Law is offering this intensive weekend assessment course at the Graduate Law Centre in Central. This fifteen-hour course is designed for arbitration practitioners aspiring to the grade of Fellow of the Hong Kong Institute of Arbitrators. Those who successfully complete the course and pass the Award-writing examination (which is set by the Hong Kong Institute of Arbitrators immediately after the course) may then apply for Fellowship of HKI Arb.

This is an assessment course. Participants must have some practical experience of arbitration, whether as counsel, expert, or as an arbitrator, and thus be familiar with the Hong Kong Arbitration Ordinance and its application. Participants will receive and be expected to read in advance, a scenario and associated documents which will form the basis of the practical exercises of the course. This is a highly interactive event, with each participant being evaluated for Fellowship suitability on the basis of participation in the discussions, role-plays and workshops. To receive a certificate of attendance, a participant must attend at least 90% of the course hours.
