This is an interactive on-line optimisation program for the selection of dispute resolution mechanisms (DRM Model) by which construction project management personnel from the international domain can be directed through a well-guided, rational and objective decision-making protocol, to choose the most appropriate DR mechanism for the particular types of dispute occurring in their specific projects. You can either use the website to learn the related dispute resolution mechanisms or enter your specific project requirements on-line to generate, based on the Model's database from expert interviews, the most appropriate DR methods for your dispute cases.

The DRM Model (on-line optimisation programme) is one of the deliverables/products resulted from a government funded (CERG) research project on dispute resolution management for international construction projects undertaken by Professor Edwin H.W. CHAN of the Department of Building and Real Estate, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (HKPolyU). The research and the product (The DRM Model) are for academic purposes and they are now developed into a stage that the DRM Model can be shared with industry on a complimentary basis for a period to look for future improvement and research potential.
