**Talk by Ms Louise Barrington – “ICC Arbitration: Getting Started”  
on Thursday 5 July 2007 at Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre**

The Hong Kong Institute of Arbitrators jointly with ICC invited Ms Louise Barrington to speak to members on the above topic on Thursday 5 July 2007 at the Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre.

Louise Barrington is an Ontario-trained lawyer qualified in England & Wales and New York, who worked with the International Chamber of Commerce for nearly eight years, first in Paris and then as the director of ICC Asia, the ICC’s first regional outpost. She currently teaches at Chinese University of Hong Kong’s new School of Law, and sits as an arbitrator in ICC and other international cases.

Founded in 1923, the ICC Court of International Arbitration is one of the oldest and best regarded institutions for resolving disputes. With experience gained in over 12,000 cases, the ICC Rules of Arbitration ensure that the resulting award will be enforceable at the end of the process. The Court takes a proactive role at many stages of the arbitral process: in constituting the tribunal, in administering the file, dealing with challenges, in scrutiny of the draft award, and in the matter of costs. Yet the autonomy of the tribunal is never in question.
