Requirements for attaining HKI Arb fellowship

- Sufficient level of practical experience in arbitration or litigation (at least 5 years post qualification experience or similar level of experience)
- Participants will be assessed by the Fellowship Assessor on (1) their performance in the simulated arbitration hearings; and (2) the quality of their draft awards.
- Suitability of participants to be a HKI Arb fellow will be assessed by the Council of the HKI Arb. Experience as solicitor, counsel, expert, or as arbitrator, and familiarity with Hong Kong's Arbitration Ordinance will be taken into account.

Award Writing Examination

- Participants will need to write an award based on the arbitration case study in the Workshop, with additional facts to be given after the Workshop.
- Date of Submission of Draft Award: 2 May 2015 (1 week after the Workshop)

About the Assessor and Trainers

Fellowship Assessor:

Prof Reyes was a judge of the Court of First Instance from 2003 to 2012. He was in charge of the Construction and Arbitration List (2004 to 2008) and the Admiralty and Commercial Lists (2008 to 2012).

Prof Reyes is now the Professor of Legal Practice at The University of Hong Kong. He also practises as a commercial arbitrator and advocate in arbitrations. He is a Fellow of the Hong Kong Institute of Arbitrators and a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators.

Assistant Trainers:

Mr Sunny Chan is a practising barrister in Hong Kong. He translated 2 books authored by Prof Reyes on civil procedure and arbitration ("Reflections on Civil Procedure under Civil Justice Reform" and "How To Be an Arbitrator: A Personal View"). He is now a part-time lecturer at The University of Hong Kong. Prior to joining the legal field, he had experience in the broadcasting industry.
