In the 21st century international commerce has increased exponentially in Asia. Savvy commercial operators know that Alternate Dispute Resolution ("ADR") is the preferred method of resolving disputes. To avoid the inconveniences of foreign litigation, arbitration is a private process that produces a legally binding decision ("award") which may be enforced in over 170 jurisdictions around the world. As one of the top arbitration venues in the world, Hong Kong is the ideal venue for this enjoyable interactive course. Lawyers and businesspeople hear from seasoned practitioners about the advantages of arbitration and how to use it.

The course will be held on 23 and 24 February 2024. There will be a pre-course assignment to be submitted before the 1st day of the course, that is, by 22 February and an examination in the form of assignment which must be handed in by 23 March 2024.

The course will be based on the Hong Kong Arbitration Ordinance (Cap 609).

Subjects covered in this course include:

- Arbitration in the dispute resolution spectrum
- Arbitration clauses
- Applicable law
- Constitution of the tribunal
- Powers of the arbitrators
- Content of the Award
- Enforcement of the Award

As space is very limited, applicants are encouraged to apply as early as possible.

Ms. Louise Barrington is a dispute resolver with 30 years of experience. She is legally qualified in Ontario, New York and England and Wales and holds a Maitrise in European law from the University of Paris II (Assas). She has practiced and taught mediation and arbitration to professionals and students for over 25 years.



In 2001 Ms. Barrington became one of Asia's first chartered arbitrators and has acted as sole arbitrator, co-arbitrator and as tribunal president, for ICC, LCIA, ICDR, SIAC, as well as in ad hoc arbitrations under UNCITRAL Rules among others. Her experience includes sales (CISG and shares), banking, franchises, insurance, construction, wrongful dismissal, intellectual property and licensing, agency and procurement under both common and civil law, on four continents. She has authored articles and book chapters about arbitration and is chief editor of *The Danubia Files: Lessons in Award Writing from the Vis Moot*. She founded and directs the annual Vis East Arbitration Moot (www.cisgmoot.org) now in its 21st year, and is co-founder and former co-president of ArbitralWomen (www.arbitralwomen.org). Louise received the CPR Diversity Award in 2011.
